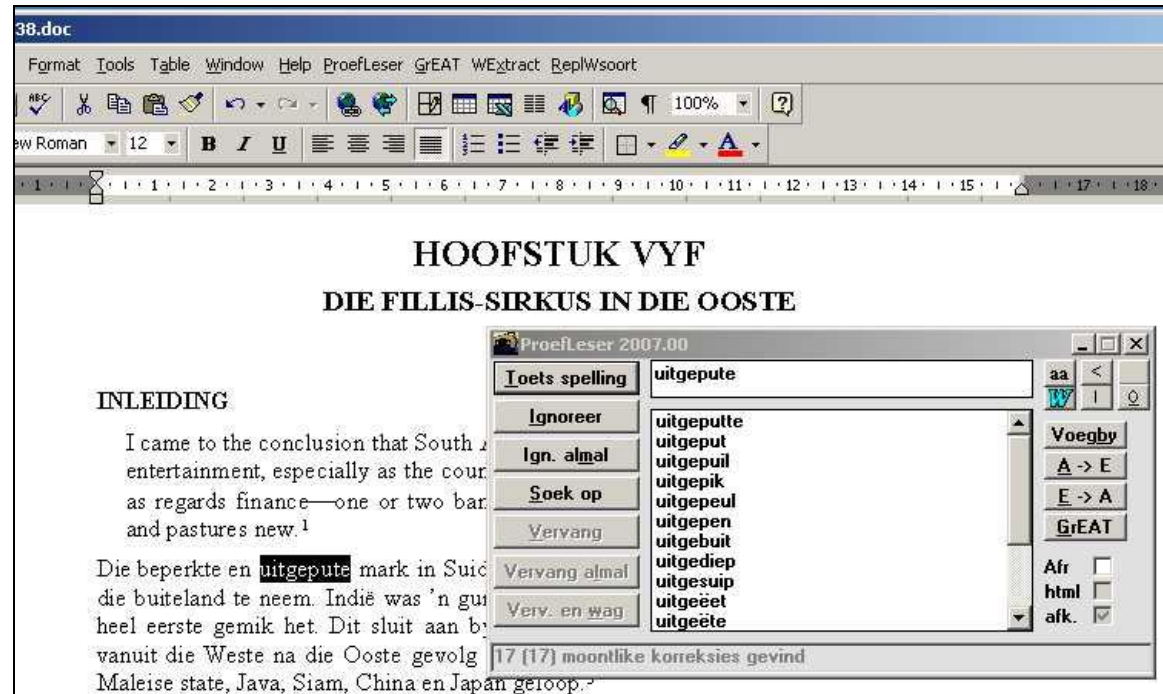


ProefLeser 2007 (shortened description)

ProefLeser is an external program (i.e. not part of WinWord).

The user loads his/her document in WinWord and then starts *ProefLeser*. Best is to mark the whole text as Afrikaans but this is not required. **Toets spelling** is clicked and *ProefLeser* will then stop at every unknown word in the text. The “error” can be ignored once (**Ignoreer**) or every time for this document (**Ign almal**). The error can be manually corrected or with the aid of the **Soek op** and **Vervang**.



In the example above, the user could manually add the second t to “uitgepute” or choose the correct word from the list.

The user can also add words to the dictionary (**Voegby**)

NB the illustration above shows that it is possible to add the starting (i.e. loading) of *ProefLeser* to the *WinWord* menu (macro) - this is an advanced feature and not required.
